## An Introduction to The Scriptures

### FAITH COMPONENT

The intention of this component is to support staff in actively witnessing to a Gospel atmosphere within the school.

The essential criterion for ongoing renewal in faith formation is a connection with Jesus Christ. Other criteria which support the formation and nurture of Christian discipleship are as follows:

- offering opportunities for spiritual formation, reflection, discernment
- flowing from and supporting evangelisation in the Catholic faith of the school community
- equipping staff to contribute actively to shaping and building a Christian school community.'

### KNOWLEDGE COMPONENT

The intention of this component is to support staff in their knowledge of the content of the Catholic faith and the pedagogical principles for transmitting it.

Inservices for the knowledge component of ongoing renewal must meet the following criteria:

- extend staff's knowledge of the scriptural and theological basis of the Catholic faith as reflected in the four sections of the Catechism of the Catholic Church (The Creed, Sacraments, Life in Christ, Christian Prayer) and/or
- extend staff's knowledge of Catholic educational pedagogy in the area of Religious Education as outlined in the General Directory for Catechesis.
